

E.H.S. DR. EDUCATION STUDENTS

I am an E.H.S. Dr. Ed. student. Can I complete the behind-the-wheel driving through R.H.S.?

Yes, you can do the behind-the-wheel driving through R.H.S. Please read the information below very carefully. *Failure to understand the R.H.S. Dr. Ed. process will only frustrate both of us.*

Please complete the following in order to begin your behind-the-wheel driving at R.H.S.:

- **Pass the E.H.S. course—Coach Galley can look up your grade via your current learner permit number. We cannot and will not drive any E.H.S. students who have not successfully completed the online course. The grade must be posted online by your E.H.S. teacher.**
- **Pay \$95 behind-the-wheel fee at the R.H.S. Main office and ask the secretary to place the receipt in Coach Galley’s faculty box along with the info described below.**
- **If you attend RHS, please take your learner permit to Coach Galley. If you do not attend RHS or if it is summertime, please take it to the Main Office and ask a secretary to photocopy it. Afterward, please write your name, phone number(s), and an email address (if you have one) on the photocopy and then ask her to place in Coach Galley’s faculty box.**
- **Study and learn “The 15 Good Driving Habits” and “Road Test Info” sheet.**
- **Study the “R.H.S. Range Expectations” sheet.**
- **Coach Galley will call or email you to begin the behind-the-wheel phase. Please realize that finishing the E.H.S. course and paying the fee does not guarantee that there is a road teacher currently available.**
- **Get assigned to a road teacher (this may happen now, but will probably happen later, maybe even weeks later...)**

You will be required to know The 15 Good Driving Habits and demonstrate them in your driving. The state road test you will be taking with us is centered on these defensive driving principles.

When you get scheduled on the range and road depends on many things: when you bring in the proper paperwork, your age, your skill level, your practice experience, when you got your learner permit, attitude--grades, availability to drive, and teacher's availability to drive. You must also understand that simply because you are finished with the E.H.S course and are eager to drive, that does not mean that we have a teacher with immediate openings for you. We have 9 road teachers that drive nearly 1,200 students per year—the driving never ends—our teachers always have plenty of students that want or need to drive. You will most likely be required to show some patience. We do the very best we can to move students through the program on a timely basis.
