

## **How Do I Get My Driver's License Through RHS Dr. Ed.?**

- ❑ **Enroll** in a Driver Education class at Riverton High School.
- ❑ Pay the **\$95** Jordan School District **fee** for Dr. Ed. in the RHS Main Office.  
**DUE DATE: Day 6** \_\_\_\_\_ *Students that do not pay the fee will not receive a Certificate of Completion. You must have this certificate in order to apply for a Utah Driver's License.*
- ❑ Bring the **fee receipt** and show it to your classroom teacher. **DUE DATE: Day 6** \_\_\_\_\_
- ❑ Acquire a **3-ring/binder or pocket folder** for class. Bring it to class **daily** with a pencil or pen, Utah Driver handbook, and paper. **DUE DATE: Get it now—checked on Day 6**
- ❑ Read and return the white class **disclosure** sheet signed by student and parent/guardian. **DUE DATE: Day 6** \_\_\_\_\_
- ❑ Complete student information section of the white RHS Driver Education **student card**. Take the card to range and road drives. A teacher will sign & record feedback on the card before returning it to you.
- ❑ Pass the **state written test** with a score of 80% or better (40 or more correct answers out of 50 randomly selected questions) at the D.L.D. or at R.H.S. (you must be enrolled in the class to take it at R.H.S.) on **Day 6** (\_\_\_\_\_).
- ❑ Drive and record **34 practice hours** (10 of these hours must be after dark or before dawn) with parent/guardian, or responsible adult following the legal conditions of the learner permit.
- ❑ Complete 6 hours of Dr. Ed. instruction on the **range** and the **road** (4 sessions each).
- ❑ Pass the **state road test** (during the 4<sup>th</sup> & final road drive) with a score of no more than 20 deductions. You must **finish all 34 practice hours** to take your road test.
- ❑ Attend a minimum of **30 hours of classroom** instruction (21 block schedule days).
- ❑ Complete and turn in all required **assignments**.
- ❑ **Pass** the class with at least a 60% average (D-).
- ❑ Turn **16** years of age.
- ❑ **Possess a valid learner permit for at least 6 months (if under age 18).**

After successfully completing the previously listed requirements you will receive a Certificate of Completion from a RHS Dr. Ed. instructor. Take the certificate, your learner permit, the \$25 fee, 2 forms of proper identification (social security card and original or certified birth certificate—*no mini birth certificate cards will be accepted*), 2 forms of parental proof of Utah residency (veh. reg., recent utility bills, bank/credit card statement), and go with a parent/guardian to the Driver License Division (don't go to the DMV!!) to apply for an original Utah driver's license. If you wear contacts or glasses, please wear them to the D.L.D. Call 965-4437 or go to <http://driverlicense.utah.gov> to find the D.L.D. office locations and operating hours—the closest current location for original licensing is 2780 W. 4700 S., West Valley City.

## **How Do I Get a Learner Permit?**

- Turn **15** years of age.
- Pass the state written test** at the D.L.D. (you may take the test twice in the same day and once on another day for the \$15 learner permit fee—if you need to take the test a fourth time or more, you will need to pay an additional \$15)

**OR**

- Pass the state written test** at R.H.S. on Day 6 of class (when enrolled in the class) and receive a certificate from your teacher that verifies you passed the written test.

### **Once you have passed the state written test . . .**

- Go to the **D.L.D.** (please, please, please, DO NOT go to the D.M.V.) with a **parent or guardian** to apply for a learner permit. Take the following items with you:
  - Picture I.D.
  - Contacts or glasses (if you wear corrective lenses)
  - Social security card or ITN card (individual tax number)
  - Original or certified copy of birth certificate (*no photocopies or miniature birth certificate wallet-sized cards will be accepted*)
  - \$15 learner permit fee
  - Certificate verifying a passing test score at R.H.S.—if you do not have one, you will be taking the test at the D.L.D.
  - Parents need to bring 2 (two) of the following items that will prove Utah residency: recent bank statement, credit card bill, or utility bill; or vehicle registration. No cell phone bills will be accepted as proof of residency.
